Applications pending decision by NCC</b><br/> <b>20/02884/CCMEIA</b> - Land North Of Shiel Dykes, U3050 Swarland Junction to Stouphill Junction, Swarland, Northumberland. Phased extraction of approximately 5 million Tonnes of hard rock and importation of inert material for use in restoration using overburden from site and imported materials over 30 year period. This application is not within the Parish but may impact on the area. The Parish Council did not object to the application subject to a range of comments. Clerk to send in response on this application.</p> <p><b>23/04725/VARYCO</b> - Discharge of Condition 2 (Approved Plans) on approved planning application 23/00106/FUL in order to enable design revisions by replacing top portion of dwelling with Cedral cladding. - Currys Cottage, Old Swarland, Swarland, NE65 9HU.
